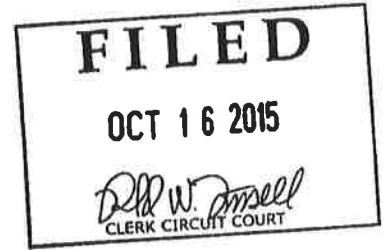


Jocelyn Parrish vs.
